**Information concerning high school division state finals – Montcalm County Fairgrounds, Greenville, MI**

1. Camping
  - a. Contestants can start checking in Friday, June 7 at 10:00 am.
  - b. Sites with water and electric - \$30.00 per night (\$60.00 for the weekend)

    - ii. Horses must be in stalls, not allowed in camp grounds.
2. Stalls – Contact Carries Harkness – 989-763-7357 or [harknesscarrie@gmail.com](mailto:harknesscarrie@gmail.com)  
 (this is for horses being used by contestants in the state finals.)
  - a. Stalls are for high school division competition horses first. Once all contestant horses are stalled others may be accommodated.
  - b. \$50.00 per stall for the weekend – do not have to clean before leaving
  - c. Only 1 horse per stall
  - d. Shavings may be available for purchase on site.
3. All members that have competed during the regular season qualify for state finals.
  4. You must have competed in an event during the regular season to compete in that event at state finals.
  5. There are no entry fees at state finals.
  6. All fundraiser requirements have to have been met (participated in 2 fundraisers, wreath sales or raffles).
  7. \$100.00 awards fee has to have been paid.
  8. Must compete at state finals in an event to compete in that event at nationals.
  9. Must have points in that event and be in the top 8 to qualify to go to nationals.
  10. Bring a copy of current grades, progress report, to state finals. Must have in order to compete.
  11. National paperwork will be filled out and fees will have to be paid at state finals.
