PURPOSE AND AIMS

To promote Junior High and High School rodeo on a state wide scale
 To encourage any student to continue in school as a regularly enrolled student and to
 improve his/her education
 To keep the Western Heritage alive in America, and the State of Michigan
 To promote the highest type of conduct and sportsmanship in its members

- Information concerning junior high state finals
1. All members that have competed during the regular season qualify for state finals.
 2. You must have competed in an event during the regular season to compete in that event at state finals.
 3. There are no entry fees at state finals.
 4. All fundraiser requirements have to have been met (participated in 2 fundraisers, wreath sales or raffles).
 5. \$100.00 awards fee has to have been paid.
 6. Must compete at state finals in an event to compete in that event at nationals.
 7. Must have points in that event and be in the top 8 to go to nationals.
 8. Bring a copy of current grades, progress report, to state finals. Must have in order to compete.
 9. National paperwork will be filled out and fees will have to be paid at state finals.
- Some notes concerning the National Junior High Finals;
1. There are no mandatory entry fees, contestants can enter the optional jackpot.
 2. Campsites are \$325.00 for the duration of the finals.
 3. All sites have water and electric.
 - a. Sites will come with 2 complimentary pump outs.
 - c. Additional pump outs will be available at \$35.00/pump.
 - d. Camping check in starts Thursday, June 20th at Noon (runs around the clock).
 - e. All contestants must be checked in by 7:00 am, Sunday, June 23.
 - f. Only 30 amp plugs are available, no 50 amp at all.
 - g. Must have accurate dimensions for camping form and any slide outs with which side they are on.
 - h. States will be camped together as a group, unless a unit is too big to fit in designated area, at which time it may be located in area separate from the group.

3. Stalling information
 - a. Mare/Gelding stalls - \$159.00/each
 - b. Stud Stalls - \$170.00/each
 - c. Extra stalls (non-competing horses) - \$245.00
 - d. No tack stalls allowed (keep all equipment, feed & other items at trailers).
 - e. All stalls include 3 bags of shavings.
 - f. Teams will be stalled together.
 - g. Altering or damaging stalls will result in a \$200.00 fine assessed to the contestants.
